

NZFCNA 2007 Faith Community Nursing Competencies/Indicators based on Nursing Council Competencies 2005

Domain One: Professional Responsibility
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Competency 1:1 Accepts responsibility for ensuring that his/her nursing practice and conduct meet the standards of the professional, ethical and relevant legislated requirements.

- Indicator: Engages in legally accountable faith community nursing practice
- Indicator: Practices mandatory reporting as stipulated by relevant statute law
- Indicator: Researches legal aspect of nursing care applicable to faith community nursing practice e.g. EPOA
- Indicator: Attends workshop/ education session on ethics in faith community nursing and reflects upon their application to nursing practice. (E.g. as provided by NZFCNA)

Competency 1.2 Demonstrates the ability to apply the principles of the Treaty of Waitangi/Te Tiriti o Waitangi to nursing practice.

- Indicator: Reads literature on the Treaty of Waitangi reflects upon it and integrates the learning into their faith community nursing
- Indicator: Attends a Treaty of Waitangi education session or workshop. (E.g. as provided by NZFCNA)
- Indicator: Consults with member/s of *tangata whenua* how the principles of the Treaty of Waitangi may impact on nursing practice in the faith community.
