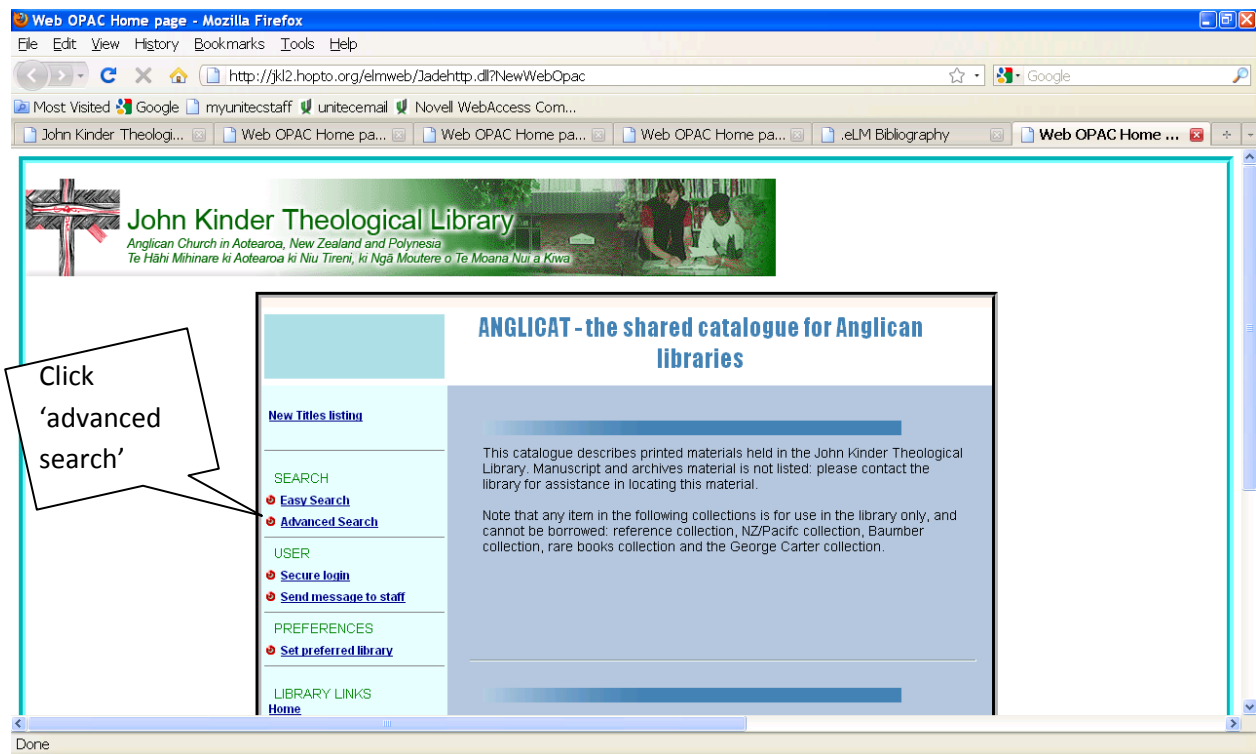
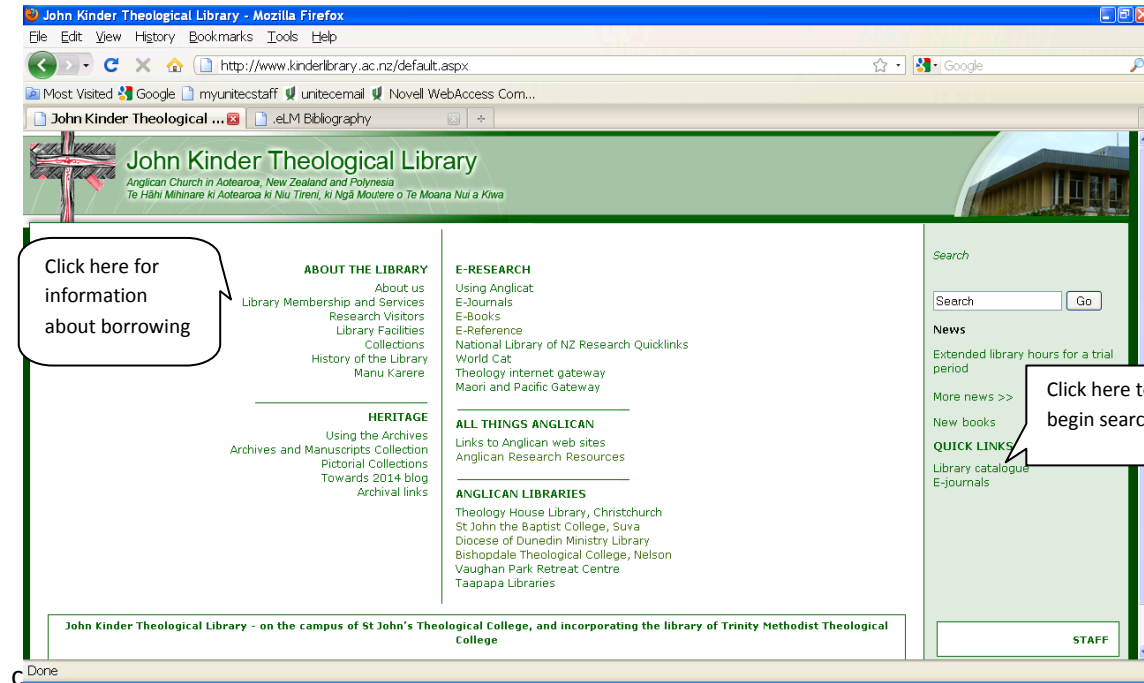
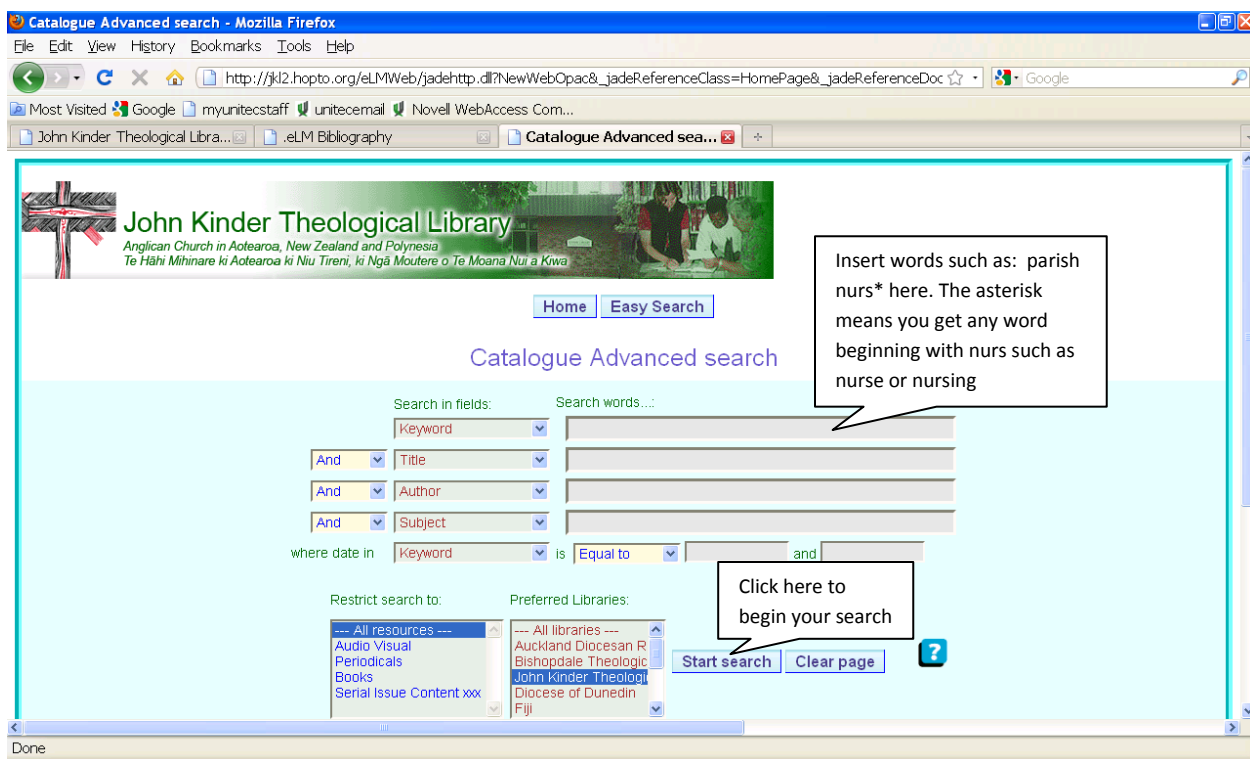

Accessing and searching the catalogue





You should now get a list of about 20 titles. The listing will tell you whether the book is 'in' the library at present. Select the book/s you would like to borrow, and use the information about borrowing – see the first pane above – to enrol if you are not yet enrolled, and then to borrow the book/s of your choice.

Key words are an important way of searching: other useful ones are 'nurs* ministry' 'holistic' 'health' and of course, combinations of these.

You can also use the boxes for author/title if you know these.

Searching for journal articles is a bit more complicated unless you are familiar with the process. If you are new to online library work you might like to explore this when you are confident with the website, or if you have someone with expertise to encourage you. The advantage of journal articles is that you can save and print what you need, and do not need to return the item.
